The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) is seeking to recruit suitably a qualified person to fill the vacant position of **FARM RANGER (PTSG/PX 3)** in the Rehabilitation Industries Branch, Rehabilitation and Probation Aftercare Division with salary ranging from **\$2,190,302 – \$2,945,712 per annum**.

JOB PURPOSE

Under the direction of the Security Coordinator, the Farm Ranger is responsible for the protective security of the farms productive assets and produce.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Technical/Professional Responsibilities:

- Secures farm assets, produce and personnel by patrolling property; monitoring surveillance equipment (Drones); inspecting buildings, equipment, and access points; permitting entry and exit.
- Inspects outgoing vehicles and personnel bags to prevent unauthorized removal of farm property or produce.
- Prevents losses and damage by reporting irregularities; informing violators of policy and procedures; restraining trespassers and praedial thieves.
- Completes reports by recording observations, information, occurrences, and surveillance activities.
- Monitors the farms for praedial theft by using quadcopter drones and photo beam technology.

Other Responsibilities:

- The incumbent may, from time to time, be assigned duties not specifically outlined within the job description but are within the capacity, qualifications and experience normally expected from a person occupying this position.
